Happy New Year!

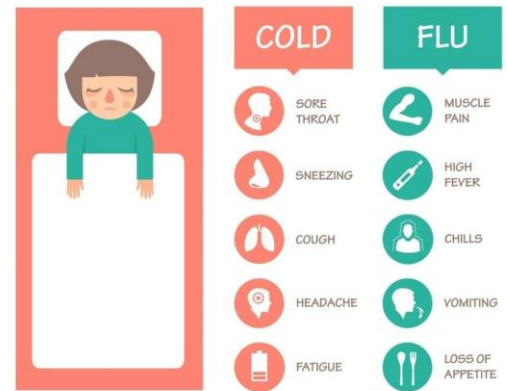
